Unatoč izazovnim vremenima i otežanim uvjetima za održavanje glazbenih događanja i manifestacija, Pučko otvoreno učilište ustajno je u organizaciji Velikogoričkog brass festivala. Ovogodišnji VG Brass oplemenit će tri glazbena žanra: suvremeni evergreeni obrađeni za brass ansamble, barokna glazba i jazz. Raznolikim programom te angažmanom vrhunskih umjetnika želimo privući pažnju ljubitelja dobre glazbe i pozvati ih na naš festival. Ova glazbena manifestacija ima sve veće značenje u promoviranju našeg grada i naše domovine te potvrđuje da Hrvatska itekako ima mjesto na kulturnoj karti Europe i svijeta. Dokaz tome su gostovanja brojnih uglednih domaćih, ali i glazbenika iz ostalih zemalja koji su nastupali u Velikoj Gorici tijekom proteklih 15 godina održavanja VG Brassa, a većina njih ostvarila je međunarodnu karijeru i stekla svjetsku slavu. Do sada smo ugostili 41 trubača, 10 hornista, 6 trombonista, 3 tubista, 8 skladatelja, 8 dirigentata, 15 ansambala i 7 profesionalnih orkestara. Na Festivalu je surađivalo 20 klavirista, orguljaša, harmonikaša, harfista, gudača, flautista i koreografa. Publiku jednostavno nije bilo moguće prebrojiti te zavidnu posjećenost koncertnih događanja ne možemo iskazati brojkama. Drago nam je što interes posjetitelja s godinama raste jer time smo ispunili svoj cilj – senzibilizaciju javnosti za limena puhačka glazbala i educiranje publike o vrijednosti glazbe.

Despite these challenging times and restrictions in organising musical events and festivals, Open University of Velika Gorica has been persistent in organising Velika Gorica Brass Festival. This year's VG Brass brings you three musical genres: modern evergreens written for brass ensembles, baroque music and jazz. By creating versatile programme and signing prominent artist we are hoping to catch the attention of lovers of good music and invite them to our festival. This event has a growing influence in promotion of our town and our homeland, and confirms that Croatia holds an important place on the cultural map of Europe and the world. Hvaljen za „svoj blješteći zvuk na trubi“ (Hyde Park Herald) i „vrftoglavu virtuoznost“ (Grunion Gazette) trubač **JUSTIN BLAND** je svestrani glazbenik koji jednako nastupa na povijesnim instrumentima, kao i na modernim trubama. Prije službenog studiranja barokne trube, Justin je osvojio prvu nagradu na Nacionalnom trubačkom natjecanju u kategoriji povijesnih instrumenata. Kao često traženi izvođač dr. Bland je nastupao s vodećim ansamblima u Sjevernoj Americi kao i u Europi, također i u Južnoj Americi. Trenutno nastanjen u Danskoj, Justin je zaposlen kao solist s vodećim baroknim ansamblima diljem kontinenta. Specijaliziran za najteža djela repertoara iz razdoblja baroka (Bachov Branderburški koncert No. 2, Koncerti Fascha, Hertela, M. Haydn...). Justin je često tražen solist. Uz trubu, vješto pjeva kontratenor te je također traženi solist i kao pjevač. Zadnji projekt mu je izvođenje povijesnih instrumenata i pjevanje aria na istom koncertu.

Applauded for his „gleaming trumpet work“ (Hyde Park Herald) and „dazzling virtuosity“ (Grunion Gazette), trumpeter **JUSTIN BLAND** is a versatile musician, performing on both historical and modern trumpets. Before formally studying Baroque trumpet, Justin won first prize in multiple historical instruments divisions of the National Trumpet Competition. As a highly sought-after solo/principal Baroque trumpeter, Dr. Bland has performed with several leading early music ensembles throughout North America. He has also played in Europe and South America. Now living in Denmark, Justin continues to perform as both a soloist and ensemble musician, combining

ongoing North American engagements with new collaborations with leading Baroque ensembles in Denmark as well as in the rest of Scandinavia and Europe. Justin specializes in playing some of the highest and most difficult trumpet pieces on historical instruments. For example, he has played J. S. Bach's Brandenburg Concerto No. 2, Fasch's concerto for trumpet, violin, and oboe d'amore, and trumpet concerts by Hertel. Justin is also a countertenor. Together with the Danish baroque ensemble BaroqueAros, he recently gave a solo concert called „Tindrende trompet og klingende kontratenor” in Musikhuset Aarhus, where he alternately played trumpet concertos and sang baroque arias. www.justinblandtrumpet.com

rođen je u Zagrebu.

Diplomirao je trubu na Akademiji za glasbo u Ljubljani u klasi prof. Stanka Arnolda. Još kao student nastupao je solistički uz pratnju Zagrebačkih solista, Zagrebačke filharmonije, Varaždinskog komornog orkestra. Nakon studija intenzivno se bavi izvođenjem stare glazbe na replikama

instrumenata iz XVII. i XVIII. stoljeća (kornet i barokna truba). Baroknu trubu i interpretaciju barokne glazbe usavršava na majstorskim tečajevima kod C. Steele-Perkinsa, M. Lairda, D. Staffa, S. Keavya, R. Farleya i M. Bennetta. Više puta je bio dobitnik stipendija Dartington Summer School iz Velike Britanije te je nastupao s *Dartington Festival Baroque Orchestra*. Redovito nastupa u zemlji i inozemstvu te surađuje s ansamblom *Antiphonus*, Zborom Hrvatske radiotelevizije, slovenskim ansamblima za staru glazbu *Harmonia Antiqua Labacensis* i *Musica Cubicularis*, austrijskim orkestrom *Haydn Akademie* te katalonskim ansamblom *La Grande Chapelle*. Solist je Hrvatskog baroknog ansambla s kojim redovito nastupa na domaćim festivalima stare glazbe poput Varaždinskih baroknih večeri i *Korkyra barok* festivala. Koncertirao je na inozemnim festivalima diljem Europe i Južne Amerike. Snimao je za Hrvatski radio i televiziju. Snimio je nosače zvuka s ansamblom *Antiphonus*, Zborom Hrvatske radiotelevizije te ansamblom *La Grande Chapelle*. Stalno je zaposlen kao profesor trube na Glazbenoj školi Vatroslava Lisinskog u Zagrebu te je stalni član sastava *Los Caballeros*.

KREŠIMIR FABIJANIĆ was born in Zagreb. He graduated trumpet playing on Music Academy in Ljubljana in the class of Stanko Arnold. As a student, he played as a soloist with Zagreb Soloists', Zagreb Philharmonic Orchestra, Varaždin Chamber Orchestra. After finishing his studies, he plays old musical pieces on instrument replicas from 17th and 18th century (cornet and Baroque trumpet). He trained baroque trumpet playing and interpretation of baroque music, on master classes with C. Steele-Perkins, M. Laird, D. Staffa, S. Keavy, R. Farley and M. Bennett. He won Dartington Summer School in London scholarship several times and he played with *Dartington Festival Baroque Orchestra*. He continuously plays in Croatia and abroad with *Antiphonus Ensemble*, Croatian Radiotelevision Chamber Ensemble, *Harmonia Antiqua Labacensis* and *Musica Cubicularis*, Slovenian old music ensembles, Austrian *Haydn Akademie orchestra* and Catalonian *La Grande Chapelle ensemble*. He is a soloist of *Croatian Baroque Ensemble*. With the Ensemble, he regularly plays on Croatian old music festivals like Varaždin Baroque Evenings and *Korkyra* baroque festival. He played on concerts in Europe and South America. He recorded for Croatian Radio and Television. He recorded with *Antiphonus Ensemble*, Croatian Radiotelevision Chamber Orchestra and *La Grande Chapelle ensemble*. He is a full time trumpet professor at *Vatroslav Lisinski* music school. He is a member of *Los Caballeros* band.



Proglasenjem pandemije koronavirusa u rano proljeće 2020. godine glazbenici, članovi **DUBROVAČKOG SIMFONIJSKOG ORKESTRA** našli su se u iznimno teškoj situaciji kako nastaviti sa svojom djelatnošću. Tijekom proljetnog zatvaranja snimali su kod kuće i producirali glazbu *online*. Ali *online* produkcija nije nikada mogla, niti će ikad moći, zamjeniti koncerте uživo, tu emociju i energiju koja se razmjenjuje, jer svaki koncert je trojedni obred skladatelja, izvođača i publike. Bez jednog od tih 3 elementa magija prestaje postojati. Nakon proljetnog otvaranja, orkestar se dijeli u manje komorne ansamble. Tako je prvo tijekom lipnja nastao Horn & Percussion kvintet u sastavu Karmen Pervitić – glockenspiel, Džemal Čakić – flugelhorn, Toni Kursar – rog, Martin Hrčan – rog, Damir Butigan – euphonium. Repertoar se bazirao na ranoj glazbi renesanse i baroka. Tijekom ljeta su se ansamblu pridružili profesori na Umjetničkoj školi Luke Sorkočevića Ivan Kušelj – truba, i Alan Polzer – bubanj i udaraljke, kao vanjski suradnici te se tako formirao današnji **BRASS & PERCUSSION SEPTET DSO-A**. Proširenje ansambla i šarolikost zvučnih boja omogućilo je obogaćivanje i proširivanje repertoara od klasike, romantizma,

filmske glazbe, jazza, funka, rocka itd. Ansambl je po svom neobičnom sastavu jedinstven u Hrvatskoj i u svijetu, a za odličan zvuk ansambla se svojim aranžmanima pobrinuo trubač, kompozitor i aranžer Damir Butigan. U repertoaru su mnoge klasične, jazz, filmske uspješnice. Posebno mjesto zauzima projekt etno-crossover skladbi baziranih na narodnim napjevima i plesovima dubrovačkog kraja. U ljeto 2021. B&P Septetu DSO-a se pridružuje principal čelist DSO-a Vid Veljak kao gost solist i ostvaren je projekt tango i latino glazbe s djelima Piazzole i Ginastere.



When COVID pandemics started in the early spring of 2020, musicians, members of **DUBROVNIK SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA**, were in a very difficult situation. They had to find the way to continue working. During the spring lockdown they recorded at home and played their music on line, but on line performance was never able to, nor will it ever be able to replace live concerts, the emotion and the energy that is being exchanged, because every concert is a trinity ritual of the composer, the musicians and the audience. If only one of these three elements is missing, the magic stops. When lockdown stopped in the spring, the Orchestra was split in smaller chamber ensembles. In June Horn & Percussion Quintet with Karmen

Pervitić – glockenspiel, Džemal Cakić – flugelhorn, Toni Kursar – horn, Martin Hrčan – horn, Damir Butigan – euphonium was formed. They played early Renaissance and Baroque music. During the summer Ivan Kušelj – trumpet, and Alan Polzer – drums and percussions, professors at Luka Skoročević Art School joined the ensemble, as part time members, and **BRASS & PERCUSSION SEPTET OF DSO** was formed. New additions to the ensemble and diversity of musical sounds enabled wider and richer repertoire from classical, romantic, film music, jazz, funk, rock and so on. With its unusual combination of instruments, the Ensemble is unique, in Croatia and in the world. A trumpet player, a composer and an arranger Damir Butigan created an original sound of the ensemble. Their repertoire includes many classical, jazz and film hits. Their special project is performing etno-crossover pieces based on folk songs and dances of Dubrovnik area. In the summer of 2021, B&P DSO Septet was joined by Vid Veljak as a principal cellist and guest soloist, on tango and Latino music project based on pieces by Piazzolla and Ginastera.



JAMES MORRISON je po svim mogućim standardima virtuoz. Osim trube, multiinstrumentalist svira trombon, klavir, saksofon i kontrabas. Sa 6 godina počeo je učiti klavir, a sa 7 je prešao na limene instrumente. Sa 9 je oformio svoj prvi sastav s kojim je već sa 13 godina života profesionalno nastupao u eminentnim noćnim klubovima. Njegova karijera se razvijala brzo nakon nastupa na Monterey Jazz Festivalu kad je imao svega 16 godina. Nastupao je na svim većim jazz festivalima uz Dizzyja Gillespiea, Herbiea Hancocka, Davea Brubecka, Chicka Coreau, Georgea Bensona, Quincyja Jonesa, Raya Charlesa, B. B. Kinga, Raya Browna i Wyntona Marsalisa. Nema jazz kluba od značaja u kojem nije nastupao (Birdland, The Blue Note and Village Vanguard...). Odlikovan je ordenom Australije, osvojio je mnoge nagrade i nalazi se u australskoj Jazz kući slave. Zasluzio je nekoliko počasnih doktorata te je profesor na Sveučilištu Južne Australije gdje vodi svoju vlastitu akademiju. Snimao je s Londonskim simfonijskim orkestrom, rock legendama INXS, nastupao je na BBC Proms, otvarao je Olimpijske igre, svirao za kraljicu Elizabetu te američke predsjednike Busha i Clintonu. Nalazi se u Guinnesovoj knjizi rekorda kao dirigent najvećeg orkestra na svijetu. Bio je gost američkog predsjednika Obame. U slobodno vrijeme se bavi pilotiranjem, vožnjom relija, pisanjem knjiga i jedrenjem.



JAMES MORRISON is, by anybody's standard, a virtuoso in the true sense of the word. Besides the trumpet, this multi-instrumentalist also plays trombone, piano, saxophone and double bass. At the age of six he started on piano, at seven he

took up brass, at nine he formed his first band and at thirteen he was playing professionally in nightclubs. His international career developed just as quickly with a debut in the USA at the Monterey Jazz Festival at age sixteen. Following this were performances at the world's major jazz festivals, including Montreux, North Sea, Nice and the Hollywood Bowl, playing with many of the legends of jazz – Dizzy Gillespie, Herbie Hancock, Dave Brubeck, Chick Corea, George Benson, Quincy Jones, Ray Charles, B. B. King, Ray Brown and Wynton Marsalis to name a few. James also frequents the world's most famous jazz clubs – Birdland, The Blue Note and Village Vanguard in New York, the New Morning in Paris, the Tokyo Blue Note and Ronnie Scott's in London. James has been appointed a member of The Order of Australia, has won countless awards and has been inducted into the Australian Jazz Hall of Fame. He has received several honorary Doctorates and is an Adjunct Professor at the University of South Australia, leading his own music Academy. He has recorded with The London Symphony Orchestra, rock legends INXS and the European Brass Ensemble, performed at the Royal Albert Hall for the BBC Proms, written the opening fanfare for the Olympic Games, played for Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth and for US Presidents Bush and Clinton. He has played classical trumpet at the Kremlin, broken a Guinness record conducting the world's largest orchestra, was TV presenter on Top Gear Australia and in 2016 was a guest of President Obama at the White House. He's a pilot, rally driver, sailor, author and even an inventor...

Paralelno sa studijem, usavršavao se na Međunarodnoj muzičkoj akademiji Kneževine Lihtenštajn, u klasi Jensa Petera Maintza i Valtera Dešpalja, a zatim kod Romaina Gariouda. usavršavao se kod eminentnih violončelističkih pedagoga, kao što su Monika Leskovar, Giovanni Sollima, Enrico Bronzi, László Fenyö, Miklós Perényi, Gustavo Tavares, Enrico Bronzi, Michael Flaxman, Xenia Janković i drugi. Pobjednik je brojnih natjecanja. Nagrađen je Dekanovom nagradom 2016. godine. Kao solist nastupao je uz pratnju Stuttgartskoga komornog orkestra, Simfonijskog orkestra HRT-a, Zagrebačke filharmonije, Dubrovačkog simfonijskog orkestra i ansambla Cantus. Kao solist i u komornim ansamblima nastupao je diljem Europe i u Kini. Osnivač je i član Riječkoga klavirskog trija. Zaposlen je kao vođa dionice violončela u Dubrovačkom simfonijskom orkestru. Profilirao se kao izvođač suvremenog violončelističkog repertoara, a posebnu pozornost posvećuje hrvatskim skladateljima. Prvim albumom *Resonance(s)* iz 2019. godine, započeo je projekt posvećen hrvatskim skladbama za violončelo solo koji za cilj ima promoviranje skladbi 20. i 21. stoljeća te poticanje nastanka novih djela.



VID VELJAK started his musical education at the age of 3 with Tatjana Skljarenko as his mentor. Then he enrolled Ivan Matetić Ronjgov music school in Rijeka with Mauro estan as his mentor.

At the age of 14, he enrolled Music Academy in Zagreb where he was invited by Valter Dešpalj in whose class he graduated in 2017. During his studies he attended training programs on international Music Academy of Liechtenstein in the classes of Jens Petera Maintz and Valter Dešpalj, and later of Romain Garioud. He attended masterclasses held by eminent cello pedagogists like Monika Leskovar, Giovanni Sollima, Enrico Bronzi, László Fenyö, Miklós Perényi, Gustavo Tavares, Enrico Bronzi, Michael Flaxman, Xenia Janković and others. He received Dean's Award in 2016. As a soloist, he played with Stuttgart Chamber Orchestra, Croatian Radiotelevision Symphony Orchestra, Zagreb Philharmonics, Dubrovnik Symphony Orchestra and Cantus Ensemble. He performed in Europe and China as a soloist or as a member of chamber ensembles. He is a founder and a member of Rijeka piano trio. He is a lead cellist in Dubrovnik Symphony Orchestra. He is a famous contemporary cello repertoire player who promotes Croatian composers. With his first album *Resonance(s)* (2019) he started a project dedicated to pieces for cello solo written by Croatian composers in order to promote 20th and 21st century musical pieces and motivate authors to make new music.
